September 8, 2020

Danville Borough Council held a meeting on Tuesday, September 8, 2020 at the Borough Building, 463 Mill St., Danville at 6:20 PM. President Herritt presided.

Present were Councilpersons Woodruff, Gregg, Beers, Herritt, Walters, Stigerwalt, Walter, Force and Mayor Swank. Also present were S. Berkey, B. Mordan, J. Swank, J. Hart, J. Buckenburger and Solicitor Marks.

The invocation was given by Solicitor Marks and followed with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Motion made by Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Walter and a unanimous vote, Council approved the following:

Action Items from previous meetings

1. Motion by Mr. Woodruff, seconded by Mr. Beers, and a unanimous vote, Council approved the MOU with Montour County for use of the Borough’s pole and meter by the site of the new Police Station.

1. Motion by Mr. Woodruff, seconded by Mr. Walter and a unanimous vote, Council accepted the only bid of \$737.00 to Wyatt Beaver for a 1998 GMC truck.
2. Motion by Mr. Stigerwalt, seconded by Mr. Beers and a unanimous vote, Council approved the Resolution and Agreement with Montour County for CARES Act Block Grant Funds in the amount of \$127,287.34.
3. Appointment of a new Borough Representative on the Montour Area Recreation Commission Board. Motion by Mr. Walter, seconded by Mr. Woodruff and a unanimous vote, Council approved Mr. Chad Roadarmel for this position.

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4. Resolution 2020-9 and the Recycling Agreement for calendar year 2021 between the Danville Borough and the Town of Bloomsburg, has been approved by a motion of Mr. Walters, seconded by Mr. Woodruff and a unanimous vote. The Resolution is setting the fee for the year 2021 to be set at \$22.00 per year beginning January 1, 2021.
5. Motion by Mr. Stigerwalt, seconded by Mr. Walters and a unanimous vote, Council has awarded Robert C. Young Inc. the Mill Street Beautification Project at \$179,962.00. (Contingent on that all labor standards have been met). This project is being funded by CDBG.
